We are excited that we have combined this year's NA3HL Showcase with another great NAPHL event featuring the T1ER and SHOW Leagues to make this weekend a spectacular five days of exposure. We are thrilled to be celebrating this grand-scale event with all of our teams, players, parents, fans, scouts, partners, and volunteers, and thank you for your support of the NA3HL and NAPHL.

The NA3HL is currently in the middle of a wonderful period of growth and advancement. Our first priority is doing the right things for the players, so they have advancement success. The NA3HL enjoys all the same events that the NAHL does and has great owners and coaches. We all share in the common mission of creating an enhanced level of play and competition that is focused on a player's development and advancement. The current 2023-24 season has been an incredible one so far for NA3HL players advancement to the NAHL, with over two dozen players getting the call up so far this season. In addition, not only did 35 NA3HL players sign a tender to play in the NAHL for the current 2023-24 season, but 28 more players were selected in the 2023 NAHL Entry Draft.

The NA3HL events are a big part of the league's successful exposure model, which includes this week's NA3HL Showcase here in Blaine, Minnesota, the NA3HL Top Prospects Tournament and the NA3HL Fraser Cup Championship Tournament, both held in late March 2024, in St. Peters, Missouri.

The NAPHL is bigger and better than ever. This weekend's T1ER and SHOW League event has all games being played under one roof to make it easier for the junior and college scouts to attend and evaluate. The goal is to create the best opportunity to showcase and advance players, which has increased the movement of players up the ladder of development from the NAPHL to the NA3HL and NAHL. We all share in the common mission of creating an enhanced level of play and competition that is focused on a player's development and advancement.

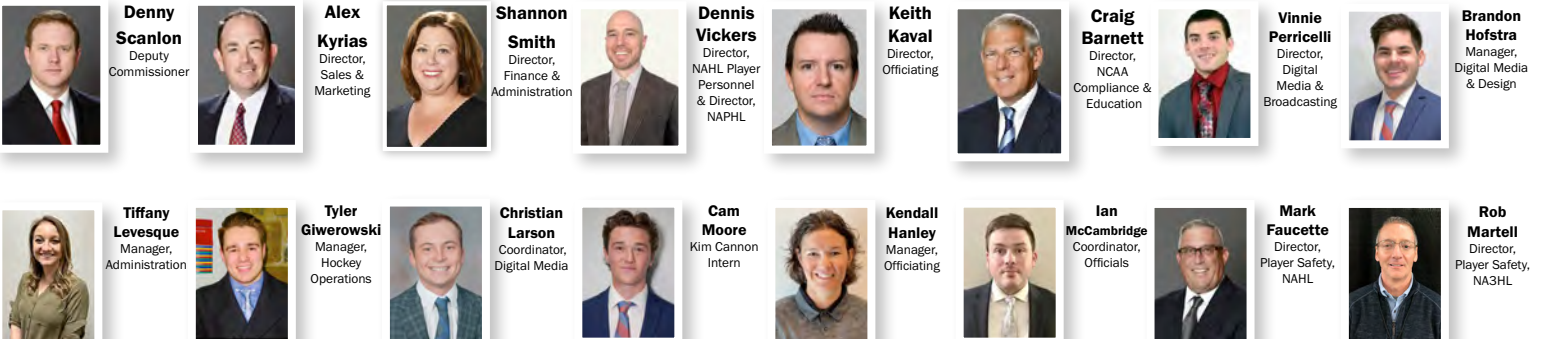

OUR HISTORY

Currently in its 14th season in 2023-24, the North American 3 Hockey League (NA3HL), is the only USA Hockey-sanctioned Tier III Junior league and serves as one of the top training grounds in the country by providing the best coaching, exposure and developmental vehicles available for student-athletes in its classification.

The primary mission of the NA3HL, which is managed organizationally by the NAHL, is to provide a structured developmental environment for student-athletes whose youth options are limited but are still reaching their potential and have aspirations of playing in the NAHL or United States Hockey League (USHL) and eventually the NCAA or American Collegiate Hockey Association (ACHA).

ON THE RISE

No other league has had more movement and advanced more players onto play in the NAHL than the NA3HL. Thanks to additional and enhanced initiatives that have been in place for the past few years in cooperation with the NAHL, more players from the NA3HL play, practice, and earn NCAA Division I scholarships with the NAHL than any other league.

Not only did 35 NA3HL players sign a tender to play in the NAHL for the upcoming 2023-24 season, but 28 more players were selected in the 2023 NAHL Entry Draft.

The NA3HL not only saw 63 of its players tendered or drafted by NAHL teams, but over 60+ NA3HL alumni played in the NAHL this past season. The NA3HL also saw seven current or former players make NCAA Division 1 commitments this past season.

The NA3HL is the only USA Hockey-certified Tier III junior hockey league and the only league that has an exclusive NAHL tendering system available only to NA3HL players. The tendering and draft pick process selections play a big part in the eventual advancement of players each season.

As part of the enhanced initiatives that have now been in place for multiple seasons, all NAHL teams engaged and worked in cooperation with NA3HL teams for increased access to players, including allowing NA3HL players to practice with NAHL teams during the season. The program created additional dialogue between NAHL and NA3HL teams to find prospects and provide them an in-season opportunity for NAHL experience and evaluation. Its direct benefits are resulted in one-of-a-kind opportunities not found anywhere else in USA Hockey-sanctioned junior hockey.

Kade Shea, F, Anchorage Wolverines (NA3HL 2021-2022) - The forward from Duluth, Minnesota joined the Rochester Grizzlies during the 2021-22 season appearing in 36 regular season games. In that span he scored eight goals and finished with 23 points. In the playoffs, Shea hit his stride scoring three goals and seven points in nine playoff contests helping his Grizzlies bring home the Fraser Cup championship. The following year he joined the Anchorage Wolverines, appearing in 53 games, finding the back of the net five times and finishing with 20 points. This season Shea has already surpassed his goal total from last year with six goals and already has 19 points in 21 games. On his way to shattering his career highs.

Nick Recupero, D, Northeast Generals (NA3HL 2021-2023) - Recupero, a blue liner from Avon, Massachusetts, also won a Fraser Cup with the Grizzlies before joining the Northeast Generals for the start of the 2022-23 season. He appeared in 13 games, scoring three times and having 12 points before earning a call up to the NAHL where he potted three more goals and 12 more points with the NAHL Generals. He's off to a great start this season with the Gens, lighting the lamp four times with 18 points through 25 games.

Hayden Walters, F, Kenai River Brown Bears (NA3HL 2021-2022) - Walters lit up the NA3HL with the Granite City Lumberjacks as he joined them midseason in 21-22. In just 13 games, Walters scored seven goals with 24 points. He continued his hot streak in the postseason, netting six goals and 11 points in nine playoff contests. He earned himself a spot on the Kenai River Brown Bears roster playing in 50 games in 22-23, scoring 12 goals and finishing with 21 points. This time around, Walters is projected to break those career high numbers as he already has eight goals and 14 points through 24 games this year.

Tyler Ramm, F, Northeast Generals (NA3HL 2020-2022) - Tyler Ramm has been in the Generals organization for five seasons, first with the NAPHL team before making his way

to the NA3HL squad. In 2021-22 he played his first full season scoring 20 goals and 42 points in just 40 games and after starting the 2022-23 season with four goals and eight points in four games, he was called up to the NAHL Generals. He went on to score three goals and nine points in 39 games. He's found a new gear in 2023 as he has scored nine goals and 13 points in 26 games.

Matvey Ivanov, F, Odessa Jackalopes (NA3HL 2022-2023) - Ivanov joined the RoadRunners in 2022-23 and lit up the league, his 39 goals were tied for second in the entire NA3HL while he led the RoadRunners and was also second in the league. He joined the Odessa Jackalopes for his final junior season and so far has four goals and six points in 24 games this year.

Reid Lune, F, Johnstown Tomahawks (NA3HL 2020-2021) - From Edwards, Illinois, the 20-year old forward played in the NA3HL with the nearby Peoria Mustangs. In 33 games in the 2020-21 season, Lune netted 11 goals and was nearly a point per game player as he had 30 points. He spent the last three seasons in the NAHL and now is off to the best start of his junior career on pace to set a new career high in points. In 13 games this season, Lune has two goals and 10 points. In 116 career contests, Lune has found the back of the net 14 times and has 44 points.

NA3HL Alum Makes NCAA Division I Commitment

The Odessa Jackalopes of the North American Hockey League are very proud to announce that former NAPHL and NA3HL goaltender [Quentin Sigurdson](#) has committed to play NCAA Division I hockey for Northeastern University in Hockey East.

“I am excited and honored to announce my commitment to play Division 1 hockey and further my education at Northeastern University! I would like to thank God, my family, friends, coaches, teammates, and everyone that has supported me along the way,” said Sigurdson. “The key to my growth this off-season was consistently putting in hard work and practicing with a purpose.”

Sigurdson, 20, is in his second season playing in the NAHL for the Jackalopes. The 6'1"/165 lbs. native of Sartell, MN, has appeared in 15 games so far during the 2023-24 season, posting a 2.13 goals against average or .939 save percentage.

“We’re excited for Quentin to further his playing career at Northeastern. Northeastern is getting a goalie that continues to develop and continues to get better year after year,” said Scott Deur, the Head Coach of the Odessa Jackalopes.

During the 2022-23 season, Sigurdson played in 15 games for Odessa, posting a 5-5-2 record with a 2.85 goals against average and a .909 save percentage.

This off-season Sigurdson put in a lot of time and effort with Jacks Goalie Coach Colin Grubb. “I’m super excited for Quentin to commit to Northeastern and head to HockeyEast, following in a guy called Connor Hellebuyck’s footsteps. He’s such a great person, his mechanics are some of the best I’ve seen and he’s had to be patient but it’s paying off this season as he’s giving us a

chance every night,” said Grubb.

Sigurdson is a ladder of development success story, having played both in the NAPHL and NA3HL. During the 2021-22 season, he played for the Granite City Lumberjacks in the NA3HL, appearing in 19 games and posting an impressive 18-1-0 record with a 1.47 goals against average and a .925 save percentage. He was named to the NA3HL All-Rookie Team that season.

During the 2020-21 season prior to playing high school hockey in Minnesota for Sartell-St. Stephen High, he played in the NAPHL’s Fall League for the Minnesota Magicians 18U team, playing in eight total games that season.

Players learn about a variety of key aspects of their hockey future, including NCAA compliance and eligibility, recruiting processes and the correct path to college hockey, as well as an in-depth look at the three different tiers of junior hockey.
- **EXPOSURE** — players compete in front of NAHL and NA3HL Coaches and NA3HL Central Scouting as they begin to build key relationships with junior teams and coaches. With NAHL Try-out Camps and the NAHL Draft taking place from May through July, NAHL Combines are a perfect indicator to evaluate just how ready they are for the next step and receive valuable feedback.
- **EXPERIENCE** — players from all over North America and Europe will play multiple games against other NAHL and NCAA hockey prospects with team's coached by staff members from NAHL, NAHL Central Scouting, and NA3HL teams, providing a top notch, professional, and memorable experience.

WHAT TAKES PLACE AT THE NAHL COMBINES

Players will be assigned to a team and receive a weekend schedule 24 hours prior to the combine. From there, each team will play four scrimmages as NAHL and NA3HL coaches work with the players behind the bench. The players' introduction to junior hockey will continue through educational seminars for both combine participants and their families.

- Junior hockey experience through four scrimmage games with coaching from NAHL and NA3HL staff members
- Participants are able to build a relationship with current NAHL & NA3HL Coaches and Scouts on the benches, and receive direct feedback during games
- In-person educational seminars about the junior hockey landscape, including:
 - o USA Hockey/NAHL partnership and the path to college hockey in the U.S. along the NAHL Ladder of Development
 - o Academic preparation and NCAA compliance seminars

The NAHL offers two different combines: A Junior Combine for junior-aged (2004-2008) players who are looking for scouting exposure to all NAHL and NA3HL teams. A Prospects Combine (2008-2010) for future Prospects of the NAHL.
